EDUCATION COUNCIL COLLEGE CREDENTIALS POLICY

Policy Statement

The College of New Caledonia (CNC) awards credentials to students upon the successful completion of programs. The College Credentials policy describes the credentials awarded by CNC and how students may use credits from other institutions to achieve a CNC credential.

Purpose / Rationale

The purpose of this policy is to define the types of credentials awarded by the College of New Caledonia.

Scope / Limits

The policy applies to all credentials awarded by the College of New Caledonia to students registered with the College.

Principles / Guidelines

The College of New Caledonia will award college credentials commensurate with the current requirements necessary to achieve the credentials. The type of credential granted for various forms of educational study is governed primarily by the number of credits required to complete it.
