ACADEMIC CONCESSIONS FOR THE 2021-22 ACADEMIC YEAR

Policy Statement

The College of New Caledonia (CNC) will make academic concessions for the 2021-22 academic year to ensure students do not attend on-campus if they are displaying symptoms of illness, or if they are self-isolating. Nor will they be penalized for responsibilities to family members who are ill.

Purpose / Rationale

A number of academic courses at CNC have attendance guidelines. During the 2021-22 academic year, CNC has made changes to these attendance guidelines to protect the college community.

Scope / Limits

This policy applies to students registered in any program credentialed or approved by Education Council, or registered in any ITA apprenticeship program, for the duration of the 2021-22 academic year.

Principles / Guidelines

1. CNC must ensure that no student is encouraged to attend courses on campus when they should be self-isolating, nor that a student is required to attend if they are the primary caregiver for others who may be self-isolating.
2. All programs must have provisions in place to allow student academic concessions for face-to face or synchronous online activities.
3. Academic concessions refer to timing of activities; students must successfully complete the course objectives in order to receive a successful grade. Academic concessions may not extend as far as creating health and safety risks for others.
